

Dear Candidate

You should have accessed, carefully checked and printed your **Admission Ticket** for MSAP by now.

Your FIRST and LAST names on your Admission Ticket must match your names on the identification you bring to the test centre. **IT IS NOT NECESSARY TO HAVE YOUR MIDDLE NAME(S) INCLUDED ON THE ADMISSION TICKET.**

BELOW ARE SOME IMPORTANT REMINDERS for your final preparations for test day on Saturday 4 March 2017:

GETTING THERE

You must **report to the test centre at the time stated on your Admission Ticket** but it is not necessary to arrive before that time. The test itself will start as soon as all pre-testing procedures are completed. If you report to the centre after all candidates have been admitted to the testing room you may not be admitted. No latecomers will be admitted once the test has started.

Please plan your travel journey and familiarise yourself with the campus map so you know where you are going, ahead of the test day. **Allow adequate time** on test day to arrive at the venue, find parking and locate the building you need to report to.

TIMING

The duration of the test is 2 hours (3 hours if sitting all three test Modules). However, when making transport arrangements you should **allow between 3 - 3.5 hours at the venue**. This includes time for checking in all candidates, pre-test procedures, instruction time, handing out and collection of test papers, and actual test time.

Candidates are not allowed to leave the test room before the test has finished. **You are therefore advised to have a good breakfast before reporting to the test centre** and take a snack to eat in the check-in queue if you think you will be hungry.

WHAT TO BRING

- **Your printed MSAP Ireland 2017 Admission Ticket** filled in and signed
(Note: Admission Tickets presented on electronic devices will not be accepted)
- Acceptable **current and photo-bearing identification document**
- Pencils, pencil sharpener & eraser
- Blue or black pens
- A clear water bottle (no labels attached)

PLEASE NOTE: You will need to bring BOTH your PRINTED Admission Ticket and an appropriate original photo-bearing ID to the test centre on the test day in order to sit the test. You will NOT be permitted to sit the test if you do not have these documents.

No food is permitted to be eaten inside the test centre.

TEST VENUE

Large spaces at the test centres can be difficult to heat/cool so to avoid being too cold or too hot, please wear layers. This way you can adjust your own comfort level and be comfortable no matter what the room conditions are.

ANY ISSUES RELATING TO THE TEST VENUE OR PHYSICAL DISCOMFORT SHOULD BE BROUGHT TO THE ATTENTION OF A TEST SUPERVISOR IMMEDIATELY SO THAT THEY CAN BE ADDRESSED WITHOUT DELAY.
